

Online Nursing Class Resources - Guide 2023

Online nursing classes can bring students together in a virtual learning environment. However, they still have to complete coursework and clinical requirements on campus.

That's why many online students use a variety of internet resources to support their studies and help them stay on track with assignments and test [NURS FPX 4040 Assessment 1 Nursing Informatics in Health Care](#).

Free Online Courses

For nurses looking to expand their skills and knowledge without the expense of a degree program, there are many online courses offered for free by leading universities. These online nursing courses cover a variety of topics and are designed to be flexible so that you can fit them into your busy schedule.

One such course is "Understanding Clinical [NURS FPX 4050 Assessment 2 Attempt 1 Ethical and Policy Factors in Care Coordination](#) Research: Behind the Statistics" offered through the Coursera platform. Developed by the University of Pennsylvania, this course is designed with beginner-level students in mind and can be completed at your own pace. Once completed, this course offers a shareable certificate that can be added to your LinkedIn profile.

Another great option is the "Integrative Nursing Specialization" offered by the University of Minnesota on the Coursera platform. This course is also aimed at beginners and covers several introductory nursing topics. Once completed, this course offers a Certificate of Completion that can be added to your LinkedIn profile. This certificate is valid for three years.

Professional Journals

Nursing students benefit from a number of professional journals, and the majority of them offer online versions as well. These publications often focus on specific health care topics and provide detailed descriptions of practice-related information. They also share theoretical explorations of care concepts and discuss the impact of existing or emerging healthcare policies.

Nursing classes often include online labs, and a virtual version of a traditional laboratory can save time and money by eliminating travel expenses. Students may still have to complete the same [NURS FPX 4060 Assessment 3 Disaster Recovery Plan](#) work, but they can do it more quickly with fewer interruptions.

Some nursing organizations host conferences, local events and webinars for their members. These can help nurses socialize and gain a sense of community while providing career growth opportunities. In addition, memberships frequently cover free subscriptions to leading peer-reviewed nursing journals.

Community

Online nursing classes are a great way to advance your career. They also offer the same resources as traditional nursing courses, including tutoring, counseling and research libraries. AdventHealth University Online, for example, gives its students access to a library of online nursing journals and allows them to meet with writing advisors to help write [NURS FPX 6004 Assessment 4 Training Session for Policy Implementation](#) research papers.

Online students must develop disciplined study skills and maintain good time-management. They may spend more time outside of class completing assignments and reading course materials, so having the ability to work independently is important.

Another important skill for online nursing students to master is virtual presentations. This can be difficult to do effectively, but there are many resources available for online students that can help them build robust and engaging presentations.

Study Tools

Online nurses can find many resources to help them prepare for exams and assignments. Nursing studies often include challenging medical information, so it's important for students to study daily. Using practice questions and studying in different environments can help students remember the material better. For example, it's important to study in a variety of locations instead of the same coffee shop or library every time.

Online tools can also support interactive classrooms. Educators can create visual presentations and offer additional resources to engage their students in remote courses. Additionally, online collaboration apps can help students work on projects and share insights with their peers.

For example, nursing students can use an app such as Quizlet to help them prepare for exams. The app lets them test their knowledge and even offers mnemonics to help them remember complex subjects like human physiology. It can also help them track their progress and identify their strengths and weaknesses so they can study more efficiently.
